On February 1st, the project team reached a significant milestone completing 35% of the construction documents

utilities, construction of rail lines, wharf repairs and major grading operations. This portion of the project, also known as the "Horizontal" phase, will commence this spring. The second phase or "Vertical" portion will consist of new modern warehouses, a new marine bulk terminal and improved rail facilities. Construction of the infrastructure will take 4 years.

The Project Team utilizes AD's database, COLLAGE, on a day to day basis for tracking and retrieving information including documents, drawings, emails, minutes, agency tracking and more. AD is proud to work with an extraordinary team of engineers and contractors undertaking this complex Public-Private project that will have major local and global economic impacts.

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
